VACCINATIONS OR VETERINARIAN RECOMMENDATION BEFORE EXHIBITING AT THE FAIR.

ALL ANIMALS WILL BE MONITORED DAILY BY THE FAIR VETERINARIAN. FFA BARNYARD SUPERINTENDANTS WILL DETERMINE WHICH ANIMALS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR THE BARNYARD EXHIBIT AND IF ANIMALS ARE TO BE RELEASED DURING THE FAIR.



Entries must be pre-registered using the registration form included in this book on page 38. Please enter everything that you **may** bring...it takes less time to delete an entry than to enter a new one. The registration form can be mailed to the fair office at the address on the form, emailed to Bentonfair@aol.com or can also be dropped of at the fair office.

ALL REGISTRATION FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 28TH.

Your entry cards will be ready in the Ag Craft building on entry day or you may pick them up at the fair office on Monday, August 4 from 11am to 3pm. All entries must be brought in ready to be displayed according to the directions for the department that you are exhibiting in. The building will be closed during judging on Wednesday, August 6 and re-open when judging is completed. Exhibits are awarded ribbons and premiums according to the different departments. All exhibits must remain on display until 5:00 pm on Sunday, August 10 when the fair closes.
